Life Stage Based Feline Preventive Care Schedule

Kitten (Birth to 1 year)

Physical Exam
Fecal flotation for parasite screen
PRC (feline panleukopenia, rhinotracheitis and calicivirus) starting at 6-8 weeks and repeated every 3-4 weeks until 16-18 weeks of age
Feline Leukemia vaccine – starting as early as 9 weeks and give 2 doses at 3-4 week interval ; core for all cats <1 year of age
Feline Rabies vaccine – starting at 12 weeks of age
FELV/FIV test – at 12 weeks of age or as directed
Intestinal and external parasite treatment
Spay/neuter
Microchip (if not done yet)

Young Adult (1-6 years)

Physical Exam
PRC vaccine (core – every three years)
Feline Rabies vaccine (core - annually)
Feline Leukemia vaccine – (based on risk – annually)
Fecal exam (annually)
Dental cleaning with dental radiographs (annually)
Heartworm and external parasite prevention – based on risk/lifestyle

Mature Adult (7-10 years)

Same as Young Adult plus consider baseline blood work and urinalysis at this age range

Senior (10+ years)

Same as Mature Adult plus
Physical exam every 6-12 months
Urinalysis every 6-12 months
Serum Chemistry and CBC every 6-12 months
Thyroid screening annually
Fecal exam: annually
Dental cleaning: annually
